2. Annual Leadership Training (see attached scheduled dates)

3. New Platform Informational Training (May/June/July 2023 – Exact dates to be published later)

2. Global Membership Approach Train the Trainer on Global Membership Approach to work with clubs (Coaching & Mentoring)
  - a. 3–5-year Global Membership Approach strategic plan
  - b. MD19 Strategic Planning Team (John Kirry, Committee Chair)
  - c. Work with Districts/Zones/Clubs to identify leaders to become Global Membership Approach leader trainers to go into Clubs to help them use/implement the Global Membership Approach process

### **MD19 Goals of forward progress & DG Support = SERVICE**

1. Training to Improve Secretary/Service Report of Service Activities
  - a. Peggy brought up statistic that club secretaries/service chair do not know how and/or actually capture member service contributions
  - b. Request that MD19 club officer training put a greater emphasis on this need.
  - c. Bigger challenge is to get these club officers to actually attend one of the upcoming club officer trainings in June, July, and August
  - d. ACTION: Sharon to evaluate/change current training info being shared with members
2. Reporting Service on New Platform – We need to improve monthly reporting. Why Report?
  - a. We need to increase our service reporting to qualify for external benevolent contributions
3. CCE Steve Noble goal for 2023-2024 Lion’s year. Have the clubs partnering with at least one other community organization; sharing involvement in service projects.
